As writers we will be learning how to write to persuade others.


## Core Texts

## Maths

As mathematicians, we will be studying fractions, decimals and percentages including ordering, comparing and calculating.

## PSHE

Focus upon our personal, social and health education will include: hygiene and a healthy, balanced diet.

## French

We will be learning language skills related to daily weather and climate.

## Science

As scientists we will be finding out about the properties of different materials and investigating whether some materials dissolve, can be separated or burn.

**Scientific Skills:** fair testing, collecting data, analysing and evaluating, planning different types of scientific enquiry, reporting findings.

**Scientific Knowledge:** knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures could be separated.

**Key vocab:** solids, liquids, gases, dissolving, filtering, sieving, evaporating, materials, reversible, burning.

## Computing

We will be using ICT to blog on cooking websites for children. We will be exploring different blogs.

## Geography

As Geographers, we will be using map skills to locate Paris, France & explore the countries of Europe. We will compare Paris to London.

**Skills:** Map reading, using an atlas, interpreting human geography, comparing different areas.

**Knowledge:** knowledge of countries of Europe. Human and physical features of Paris & London.

## Design and Technology
